

Historic Investments for School Greening

California's schools cover more than 130,000 acres and much of that area is paved and unshaded. As California faces record heat, many local public schools were built decades ago, have outdated electrical and air conditioning systems and have no or limited shade for students.

Yes on Prop 2 authorizes a \$10 billion investment – without raising any taxes or fees – to make sure our students are safe and ready to learn.

Prop 2 will:

- Advance state energy goals and support outdoor learning environments, including to directly shade and protect students from extreme heat and incorporate nature and natural materials.
- Protect students that are vulnerable to extreme heat with funding for air conditioning and playground shade structures
- Provide safe drinking water at schools, and remove asbestos, mold, lead pipes and other dangerous environmental hazards.
